Aged Care Visitor Access Code

An <u>Industry Code for Visiting Residential Aged Care Homes during</u> <u>COVID-19</u> has been released by aged care peak bodies and consumer advocacy organisations.

The Code creates a nationally consistent approach that ensures residents can receive visitors while minimising the risk of spreading COVID-19. The Code was finalised after public consultation with consumers and aged care providers.

The Code includes the respective rights and responsibilities of providers, residents and visitors. It also outlines that residential aged care services should allow residents to meet their visitors in a way that minimises the risk of COVID-19 being introduced or spread within a residential facility.
